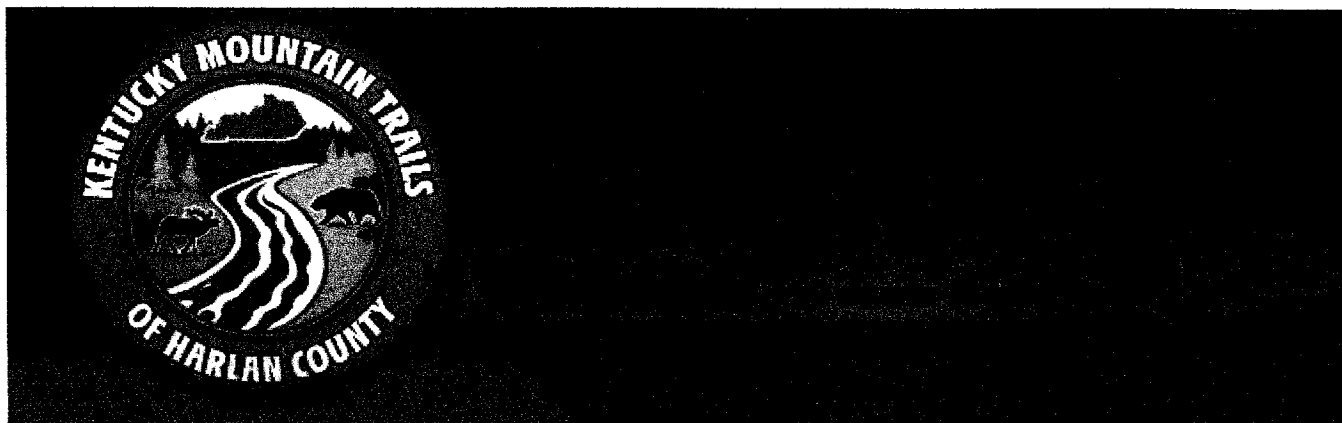


RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Everyone rides at their own risk. Know your limitations and do not exceed the capabilities of your vehicle.
2. No alcoholic beverages or mind-altering substances, which may impair a person's judgment are allowed in the trail riding area.
3. No one is allowed to possess any dangerous or controlled substances including, but not limited to firearms and explosives within the park.
4. Litter laws are strictly enforced. Place litter in an appropriate trash receptacle or "Pack It In, Pack It Out."
5. "Tread Lightly." Ride only on established trails. Do not venture in to the woods or on to other property not owned by the park.
6. Do not remove or destroy trees, shrubs, plants or animals. We want them to remain for everyone to enjoy. Tree straps must always be used.
7. No hunting is allowed in the park.
8. No open fires are allowed in the park. Campsite fires must be kept inside the designated fire rings. Fire rings are not to be moved. Do not burn metal or glass in the fire rings. Firewood is available at the front office at a charge of \$8 per wheelbarrow load.
9. Off-Road Vehicles (ORVs) are to be operated from 9 am to sunset only.
10. Excessive speed and reckless driving is not permitted. Please follow posted speed limit signs.
11. All Off-Road Vehicles (ORVs) must have a functioning spark arrestors and mufflers.
12. All operators of Off-Road Vehicles must have a valid driver's license. These will be checked and left at the check-in/check-out desk in the front office until you exit the park.
13. All Off-Road Vehicle drivers and riders should follow the manufacture's safe operating procedures. Please be sure that your ORV has the appropriate equipment needed to operate on the rough terrain in the park.
14. No person under the age of 18 may operate an SUV within the park.
15. All SUVs must have liability insurance.
16. Passengers are allowed in SUVs, but must sign a Release and Waiver of Liability Form, and must also wear their seat belt at all times while in the vehicle.
17. All SUVs must have a fully enclosed metal cab and / or roll bar protection, functioning safety belts, working four wheel drive systems, frame mounted (not welded) tow hooks that are appropriately rated for the vehicle's weight for recovery purposes, and must be in good and safe mechanical operating condition.
18. Those under the age of 18 must have a waiver consent signed by a parent or legal guardian in the presence of a park staff member. Parent / legal guardian must closely supervise minors.
19. All ATV and Motorcycle drivers are required to wear DOT-approved safety helmet, protective gear including, but not limited to those items listed by the manufacturer and the ATV Safety Institute are strongly recommended.
20. Passengers are not allowed on ATVs or motorcycles.
21. Be courteous of other drivers and Park Employees on and off the trails.
22. Failure to comply with the above rules, regulations and safe operating procedures can result in your being temporarily or permanently banned from using the park or participating in any future park activity or event. No refund of any monies will be given.
23. The park is neither liable or responsible for damage, loss, or theft of personal property or injury to visitors.
24. All riders must follow the age restrictions set by the government for ATV's (see below).

For engine sizes **under 70cc**, ages six (6) and older.
For engine sizes **70cc to 90cc**, ages twelve (12) and older.
For engine sizes **over 90cc**, ages sixteen (16) and older.

Black Mountain Recreational Park Rules

This park operates, and everyone rides at his or her own risk under KRS 411.190. Know your limitations and do not exceed the capabilities of your vehicle.

1. Helmets are required pursuant to KRS 189.515. Protective gear including, but not limited to those items listed by the manufacturer and the ATV Safety Institute are strongly recommended.
2. Consumption of Alcohol while or before operating a motorized vehicle is NOT permitted. No one is allowed to possess any illegal substances including, but not limited to, drugs and explosives within the park.
3. Litter laws are strictly enforced. Place litter in an appropriate trash receptacle or "Pack It In, Pack It Out."
4. There will be no toleration for fighting. Any violation of this rule will result in being banned from the property and possibly being arrested.
5. Do not remove or destroy trees, shrubs, plants or animals (except in approved hunting areas and approved hunting seasons). Further do not feed any animals including, but not limited to bears.
6. The park is neither liable nor responsible for damage, loss, or theft of personal property or injury to visitors.
7. Citizens Band Channel 3 & 4 will be the community channels.
8. All operator and passengers of cars, trucks, buggies, etc., designated for on or off road use must wear safety belts while vehicle is being operated. Infants and children must be restrained in legally required child safety seats.
9. All Off-Road Vehicle drivers and riders should follow the manufacture's safe operating procedures. Please be sure that your ORV has the appropriate equipment needed to operate on the rough terrain in the park.
10. An adult should supervise minors at all times.
11. Be courteous of other drivers and Park Employees on and off the trails.
12. All vehicles must operate in a manner to avoid incidents and/or accidents while in the park.
13. No glass containers are allowed at the park.
14. The Board must approve any new trails, outdoor fire areas, or camping/campsite areas.
15. All riders should use designated entrances.
16. All Vehicles must have front & rear lights if driving at night.
17. Vehicles attempting Level 5 trails must have a full roll cage and helmets.
18. Camping/Campsites must be in designated areas only.

19. Fires must be restricted to designated areas only.
20. Firewood used must be dead wood only.
21. The Board must approve all special events including vendors.
22. Pets should be kept on leash at all times.
23. Vehicles should travel in groups of 2 or more, except in emergency situations.
24. The terrain is constantly changing. Check each hill. Ride all trails with caution.
25. Stay within the boundaries of the park. Do not enter any property not owned by the park. Do not enter any posted areas that are not open by the park.
26. Tread lightly. All participants must stay on trails. Do not blaze new trails.
27. Non-operative vehicles should be moved to the side of the trails and attended to immediately.
28. Failure to comply with the above rules, regulations and safe operating procedures can result in fines, temporary or permanent banning from using the park or participating in any future park activities or events.

For your safety, these rules must be followed by all guests. By signing a release of liability waiver you are acknowledging that you understand and agree to these rules!

1. NO one under the age of 18 is permitted to check in without a parent or guardian WITH proof of legal guardianship. Youths under the age of 18 are required to have a waiver of liability form, a consent form for a minor, a medical information form, and an authorization for medical treatment form! Those under the age of 18 must also be accompanied by a person 18 years of age or older to ride at Mule Ridge. Please include the person's name on the authorization for medical treatment form that is accompanying your child during check in. Click on the blue links above if you need to download any of these forms.
2. ALL forms must be notarized to be accepted!!
3. NO ALCOHOL is allowed on the property! All vehicles are subject to search before entry into the park.
4. Flags are required for all ATV's. Flags must be a minimum of 2 feet above the vehicle.
5. Helmets are required at all times for all ATV and bike riders. NO exceptions! NO warnings will be given!
6. NO riding double on any ATV or bike except those machines specifically designed by the manufacturer for doubles riding.
7. There is a 5 mph speed limit in the parking area.
8. NO rain checks or refunds will be given for breakdowns!
9. Multi-day passes must be paid for IN FULL as you enter the park on the FIRST DAY!
10. NO buggies, sand rails, trucks, or jeeps allowed.
11. All trails and tracks are 2 way, and for multiple uses.
12. Visitors must stay in the posted areas of the park.
13. Do not be destructive.

14. Please pick up ALL trash. Anyone caught littering WILL be prosecuted!
 15. NO swimming in the pond.
 16. NO riding permitted on the pond banks.
 17. DO NOT cross any down fences.

We look forward to seeing you! Please remember that Trail Riding is a privilege. Respect our Rules, have fun, and join our goal to help make Southern Maryland one of the biggest and best family friendly ATV Parks on the East Coast.

NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS! "Zero Tolerance" Sorry Friends, you are more than welcome to bring a Cooler full of Goodies, your Grill, Car Camcorders, Radios, etc. But please leave the Alcohol at Home.

1. Follow ALL rules: You will have 2 warnings, then you will be asked to leave.
2. All riders must follow required ATV age requirements (proof of age may be required)
3. Must have full-faced helmet.
4. Must wear protective eye goggles. **NO** sunglasses.
5. Must wear gloves with grip.
6. Use headlights at **ALL** times (if equipped).
7. Must wear over ankle boots. No rubber boots allowed.
8. Stay on designated 2 way wooded trails. **NO** trail blazing or blaze cutting.
9. Follow all signs on track and trails.
10. **NO** smoking on track, trails and picnic areas.
11. **ONLY** 4 wheel ATVS and dirt bikes permitted. **NO** go-carts or wheelers.
12. No doubles (passengers).
13. **All riders 16 and under must wear a chest protector to ride.**
14. Minors (17 and under) need *signed permission slip* from **BOTH** parents.
15. Minors must be accompanied by an adult and that adult must remain on the premises to supervise at all times.
16. Minors under 18 years of age cannot ride the trails without accompaniment.

17. Return all litter from the picnic areas back to the parking lot disposal.
18. No riding in parking lot area, except to and from your tow veh
19. **NO WHEELIES OR DONUTS** in the parking area.
20. Slow down when approaching the track area from the trails.
21. Use track area for warm-up before entering wooded trails.
22. Must return to track area $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before closing time.
23. Observe track towers if yellow flag is displayed (slow down).

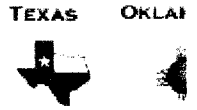
